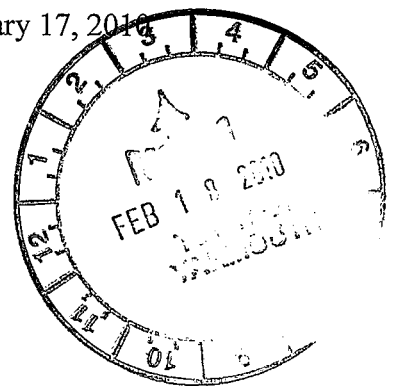

I am sure council will agree in the past few years that gasoline, repairs and insurance costs have risen dramatically, and I have been taking the brunt of the costs from my own pocket.


I have had to purchase a new van to use when the 18 passenger bus is out of service, and have also purchased a new 18 passenger bus in the last 2 1/2 years.

This service would certainly be missed if I were forced to look at alternative routes and days of operation to try and cut expenses.

Although my financial statement for the Year Ended December 31, 2009 are not completed at this time, my books are at the bookkeepers to be prepared. They will be available at a later date, if required.
