

BY-LAW NO. 2

BOUNDARIES BY-LAW

1. The boundaries of the Town are as follows:

Beginning at the junction of Wetmore Street with Bain's Road (now called Prospect Street);

Thence running Westwardly by the centre of Prospect Street to Bain's Pond;

Thence Westwardly across said pond to the Alder Cove, so called;

Thence up said cove to the Southern line of land formerly of Hugh D. Cann;

Thence by said line to the highway leading to Chegoggin;

Thence across said highway to the entrance of Lovitt's Road, so called;

Thence Westwardly by Lovitt's Road to land formerly of Israel Lovitt;

Thence by said land Southeastwardly to the harbour of Yarmouth;

Thence by the harbour, past the South end of Harris Island, Eastwardly to the main channel;

Thence by the main channel Southwardly to what was in 1890 the West or outer end of Commercial Wharf;

Thence Southeastwardly to the shore at the line on the North side of land formerly of Amasa Durkee;

Thence Eastwardly to the Southwest corner of land formerly of George S. Brown and known as "Clark's Hill";

Thence Northwardly by the Western line of said land formerly of George S. Brown to Argyle Street;

Thence crossing Argyle Street to the centre of McConnell Street;

Thence Northwardly by the centre of McConnell Street to Forest Street;

Thence Northwardly across Forest Street and by land formerly of Joseph McConnell to the Southeast corner of land formerly of George S. Brown;

Thence by the Eastern line of said land formerly of George S. Brown to Starr's Road;

Thence Northwardly in a straight line to the Southeastern corner of a farm formerly of Zachariah Corning;

And thence Westwardly by the Southern line of said farm formerly of Zachariah Corning to the place of beginning.
