

## **BY-LAW NO. 29**

### **REPEAL BY-LAW**

1. Subject to Section 3 of this By-Law, from and after the date upon which these By-Laws shall be approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs, all existing By-Laws of the Town shall cease to have force and effect, and are hereby repealed.
2. Notwithstanding Section 1 of this By-Law, any violation of any By-Law of the Town arising before the date of approval of these By-Laws shall be enforced by the Town as if this By-Law had not been approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and any assessment, rate, charge, tax, fee, liability, fine, or penalty outstanding under any existing By-Law of the Town may be collected by the Town as if this By-Law had not been approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.
3. Notwithstanding any Section of this By-Law, the following By-Laws, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, as if not repealed:
  - (a) Boundaries By-Law, except Section 2 thereof;
  - (b) Zoning By-Law, adopted on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1977; approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the province of Nova Scotia on October 5, 1977, together with all amendments thereto, as listed on Schedule "A" attached to this By-Law;
  - (c) Subdivision By-Law;
  - (d) Collection, Storage, and Disposal of Garbage By-Law, adopted by Council on March 11, 1982, and approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the Province of Nova Scotia, on April 21, 1982;

- (e) Heritage Property By-Law, adopted by Council on March 11, 1982, and approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the Province of Nova Scotia on April 21, 1982;
- (f) Noise By-Law, adopted by Council on March 11, 1982, and adopted by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the Province of Nova Scotia on November 26, 1980;
- (g) Parking Tax Assessment Area by-law, adopted by Council on November 10, 1980 and approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs for the Province of Nova Scotia on November 26, 1980.
- (h) Taxi by-law adopted by Council on July 9, 1976 and approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs on July 22, 1976 and an amendment approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs on February 13, 1981.
