

CAMERAS AND MICROPHONES POLICY

1. The number of cameras will be limited by the Chairman of the meeting and in the absence of any other rule there shall only be one set of cameras in the Council room at one time.
2. Once cameras and microphones are placed they shall not be moved during the meeting of Council.
3. Cameras and microphones will be in place before the meeting begins and will not be removed until after the meeting is completed.
4. The activities of the camera men and microphone people will be subject at all times to the direction and control of the Chairman of the meeting and any activities and movement with respect to cameras and microphones will be done so as not to interfere in any way with the deliberation of the Council.
5. The company whose cameras and/or microphones are permitted in the Council Chambers shall provide at no costs to any of the users, the material, both visual and audio to any other broadcaster who so requests a hookup or feed at no cost to the other broadcaster, provided the other broadcaster provides equipment for receiving the visual and/or audio material.
6. All broadcast material is to be maintained in a safe and useable condition for one month following the date of recording and shall be made available for viewing and/or listening, to any and all Councillors of the Town of Yarmouth at no cost to the Councillor, with the proper viewing and listening equipment to be provided by the broadcaster
7. Any meeting of Council recorded by Cable Television shall be shown in its entirety without editing by the Company.
