Re: Tender – Pleasant Street
Reconstruction

Tenders were publically advertised in the local paper, the Vanguard, and the provincial edition of the Chronicle Herald for the reconstruction of Pleasant Street (Herbert Street to Prospect Streets) in the Town of Yarmouth.

Four responses were received with the results as summarized below:

Aberdeen Paving Ltd.	\$2,873,300.00
ACL Construction Ltd.	\$3,524,382.75
D.J. Lowe (1980) Ltd.	\$4,037,873.03
Amber Contracting Ltd.	\$4,863,662.00

Note: The above pricing is exclusive of HST.

The consultant, CBCL Ltd., has reviewed the tenders and has compared the unit pricing to their estimate using a bid comparison spreadsheet. The lowest tender is within the budget which was approved for funding under the Federal / Provincial Infrastructure Program. The approved amount for the project was \$3.9M including net tax, with the Town's portion being \$1.3M. After reviewing the tenders and requirements to be compliant, it is recommended that the tender be awarded to Aberdeen Paving Ltd. in the amount of \$2,873,300.00 plus HST.
